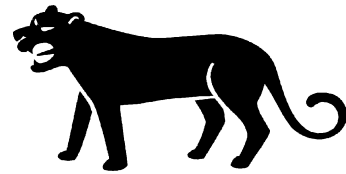


# Faith-O-Gram
